The present guide is to give the interested public an idea of the structural features and interior decoration of the building which was erected in 1755 as the Aula of the University of Vienna and has accommodated the Academy of Sciences since 1857.

This publication owes its existence first and foremost to my colleagues Dr. Herbert Karner and Univ.-Doz. Dr. Werner Telesko. They have been kind enough to include my name in the list of authors even though my share is limited to contributions on the work of Franz Anton Maulbertsch and editorial activities.

In the interest of readability we have refrained from discussing in detail a number of recent research findings, which we hope will be made available to the scientific world in a separate, more detailed publication.
