The two bluffs extreme upper right are the two buttresses of the main Rock gate or Shih-men (rear).

14 (p. 57) The preliminary Shih-men or Rock gate at the head Tsha-lu valley. The trees to the left are *Picea purpurea* Mast. Through the narrow defile a trail leads over logs into the broad valley which confronts the main Shih-men of the backbone of the Min Shan, three miles instant. One of the buttresses of the rock gate is visible in the distance; elevation at foot of cliff 11000 feet.
