Looking down Ma-ya kou from a bluff elevation 8000 feet. The horizontal trail in centre of picture is south of the Pai-lung Chiang. The valley opposite To-erh kou, ist branch on the right is A-hsia kou (valley). For description of flora see Ma-ya kou chapter.



36 (p. 95)

View down Ma-ya kou (valley) from an elevation of 10600 feet, from below the summit of Lha-mo gün-gün pass. The trees are Abies, and *Picea Wilsonii* Mast., *P. asperata* Mast., and *P. purpurea*, with an occasional *Juniperus squamata* forma *Wilsonii*, the latter along the margin of the small meadow in lower centre of picture.
